The event will be held under the General Regulations of the Motor Sports Association (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA) and these supplementary regulations and any other instructions the organising club may issue for the event.

Permit

This event will run as a Touring Car Assembly. Permit No. 83389

Eligibility

This event is open to all vintage, classic and 'modern classic' cars.

Start Venue

The start venue has been provided at Goltho Gardens, Wragby where tea/coffee will be provided within your entry fee. Fuel is available from several stations within a 10 mile radius. Please contact the organisers for locations.

Finish Venue

The event will finish at The Willows Garden Centre, Glentham where tea/coffee and cakes will be provided for your refreshment.

Route

The route shall be about 120 miles taking in rural surfaced roads and inspired by Lincolnshire's beautiful surroundings.

A descriptive roadbook will be provided at the start with points of interest marked within. If you wish to bring your OS maps (not necessary) then maps 113, 121 and 122 will be used.
